# Suffering can be positive! by cliff Holladay

Some people may act very negatively when suffering comes their way. They may make ståtements like these:

"God is punishing me!"

"I am tired of fighting against temptation. I am now going to follow wherever my pleasure leads me..."

"If there is a God, why did He let this person die that I loved so much? I prayed to God that this person might live but he died. I don't believe in God any more."

We then overlook the fact God's only Son went through deep suffering that we may never face. Jesus met every kind of temptation that we face. Yet He did not turn away from God His Father. (Hebrews 4:14-16)

If we analyze (study) human suffering, we may be able to come up with some reasons why we suffer.

First, suffering may strengthen our faith in God and humble us as His children. This can be seen in the story of Job.

Second, when we have won a victory over suffering, we may be able to strengthen a weak brother in Christ or to bring someone to the Lord.

Third, suffering may be a way to discipline us and to keep us directed toward the Lord. (Hebrews 12:6-11)

Fourth, through our suffering we can feel sympathy toward others and not just pity.

We may be able to find certain answers to why some people suffer. But whether we find the answers or not, the questions still remains: "What will I do if suffering comes into my life?"

You see, the answers to why are not really as important as what action will I take in my life if I meet suffering in my life.

Will I live my life with an attitude of defeat? Or will I find victory because I have faith in God? (1 Corinthians 10: 10: 13) Which will we say?

"I am defeated. "

"I can do everything through Him who gives me strength." (Philippians 4:13)

"For when I am weak, then I am strong." (1 Corinthians 12:10)

What will be your answer?

We are using some questions from a reader in a recent letter sent to us. We thought you would like to see these questions and the answers we give.

### Sex is digusting.


We must be careful not to have the wrong idea of sex. Adultery and other kinds of sexual sin are wrong. But if you are sorry for your sins and decide never to do them again, you can be forgiven. See 1 Corinthians 6: 11 (compare with verses 9-10), and also Titus 3:3-5 and Hebrews 10:22. Sex in marriage is beautiful. The Bible encourages husbands and wives to enjoy sex with each other. See Proverbs 5:15-20 and 1 Corinthians 7:2-5. But remember. God intends for sex to stay in marriage!



Can God destroy your body if you have sex?

Remember, sex in itself is

not wrong. It is beautiful and right if it is between husband and wife. But if you try to get sex outside of marriage, then it becomes sinful and wrong. When a person does sexual sin, God does not do the destroying of the person's body. Notice Romans 1: 26: God left these sinners alone. He let them do the shameful things they wanted to do. It doesn't mean God doesn't care. Yes. God cares! And He is sad about these sinners because He loves them all. But if they refuse to listen to Him, then He will leave them alone. He will let them mess up their own lives. Now notice the last part of Romans 1:27. It says that homosexuals punish themselves. How? They receive punishment in their bodies for the wrong things they did. This means diseases that pass from body to body in sexual intercourse. Homosexuals are not alone, men who sleep with many different women can get diseases also. This way their bodies are destroyed, but it is the sinners who punish themselves, not God.
