
# The Marriage Feast of the King's Son

Matthew 22:1-13






The king told his servants to tell his guests to come to his son's marriage feast.




But when the servants met the guests and told them the feast was ready, the guests laughed.







Another guest went to his store...



But the other guests killed the king's servants.




When the king heard what happened, he was angry.






The soldiers burned the city of the evil people.

The king came in to see his guests.






He saw one with no wedding robe on.

## The MEANING of the Parable

Now that you have read Jesus' parable of the Marriage feast of the king's son, it is time to dig out the meaning of the story. (Parables are stories that have a meaning to them.)

What does this one parable mean?

First, the king means God Himself.

And of course the son is Jesus, God's Son.

Who is the "bride"? God's people.

When the apostle John wrote the book of Revelation, a voice told him, "Write, 'Blessed are they which are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb, " (Revelation 19:9) All people are called, but not all will go into the kingdom of heaven. (Matthew 20: 16)

First, God called the Jews. But they refused to obey God. So God took the kingdom from them and gave it to a "nation" which in this case means the church. (Matthew 21:43)

You remember how cruel the guests were to the king's servants in Jesus' parable. In the same way evil people have been cruel to the servants of Jesus who spread the Good News (gospel). These evil people will be punished one day. In fact this world will burn up someday! (2 Peter 3:10)

And remember all kinds of people were invited to the

feast. All are invited to a wonderful home with Christ heaven. (Acts 15: 7 9, Ephesians 3:6) But must have on a "wedding robe". Paul tells us " put" on Christ when believe Christ on baptized. (Galatians 3:26,27) If we do not put on Christ, we are "naked" (Revelation 16: 15) When we try to put on our own "clothes" (right eousness), they are like filthy, smelly rags in front of God. (Isaiah 64:4)

Only Jesus' blood can cleanse us from our sins. (Revelation 1:5, 1 John 1:17 and Colossians 1:14)

This happens when we believe in Jesus and obey Him. (Acts 16:31, Hebrews 5:9)




# Wilmer Kingsley



We were sorry to hear of Wilmer Kingsley's recent death on December 12, 1986. Brother Kingsley was one of our earliest readers. I met him personally when I went to Wichita, Kansas, where he lived, back in 1978, and again in 1984 at the National Workshop for the Deaf, held at Overland Park Church of Christ in Overland Park, Kansas. He has a deaf daughter, Jenean, and a deaf grandson, Lane. Below is a reprint from the bulletin for Cleveland Avenue Church of Christ where Brother Kingsley had his membership. Since 1960 Wilmer and his family have been connected with this congregation. There are many ways he contributed to this church and God's kingdom. serving as a deacon and elder; teaching in home Bible studies; signing our worship services for the deaf; teaching sign language classes; teaching over 1,100 students through World Bible School; serving unselfishly in other areas. There are a number of ways Wilber will be remembered, but perhaps more than anything else his evangelistic spirit stands out as a powerful testimony to those of us who knew him. Wilmer's efforts in making disciples provided an example that will not soon be forgotten. With his death on December 12, Wilmer is now enjoying what he has encouraged so many others to consider: eternal life with God and His Son, Jesus Christ.

Good interest was shown in our question and answer page last issue. This issue we bring more questions from the same letter that we used last issue.

If a person has done sexual sin before marriage, can he have sex with his wife after he marries?

Yes. Sex before marriage is a sin, but like any other sin it can be forgiven if the person repents. The word "repent" means to change your heart and life. It means to decide never to do the sin again. (See Acts 3:19)


If the person had sex with many people, it may be wise for him never to marry. because he may have received disease in his body. He would spread this disease to his wife This is if he later marries. the cost of sin no matter if vou are forgiven. the scars of sin can continue all one's life on earth. Better to listen to God's teaching and save your body for your future wife or husband than to be sorry!

Please explain 1 Corinthians 7: 25-28.

Let's look at the background first. The people in the church wrote Paul a letter and asked Paul if it was all right for people to get married. (See verse 1). That is why in verse 1 Paul said, "It is not good for a man to marry."

Some people misunderstand Paul and think he was against marriage. No. Paul was not against marriage. It just was a bad time. It was near the time for the Roman government to persecute (do bad things to) the Christians. At another time or in another country. marriage would be fine. not in Corinth at that time. what Paul That is talked about. But if a person was already married. then he shouldn't divorce his wife just to avoid the trouble from the government. (Verse 27) He should stay married. if a person still wanted to marry, then he should go ahead and marry, it is not a (Verse 28) sin for him. he is hungry for sex, it better for him to go ahead and marry. Then he can be free to have sex with wife. (Verse 9)

I believe that all the above will correctly explain the passage that is puzzling you so.
