



## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The answers given to the questions below are the responsibility of the **Editor**.

If a person doesn't pray and talk to God for a long time, can other people bother him or can a person forget God quickly?

The person who does not communicate with God regularly may be in danger of allowing evil influences to win him over. Why? Because when a person prays to God, that person is allowing his mind to think over things. Romans 8:6 may be helpful for you to under-"If a person's thinking is controlled by his sinful self, then there is spiritual death. But if a person's thinking is controlled by the Spirit, then there is life and peace." if a person does not pray to God for a long time, likely he is not at all trying to live the Christian life, but is controlled by his sinful self.

If a person has sex with a woman out of marriage, will the person's mind be ruined? I know myself if a person repents or talks to God, God will forgive the person if he never does that again.

If you mean that the person's mind is destroyed such that he cannot think clearly any more, my answer is that a person's mind is not always destroyed by his having sex out of marriage. The Bible does not say that! But if the person receives a disease from the

woman he has sex with, the disease could possibly destroy his mind. Gonerrhea does that if it is not treated, but it takes many years before it finally destrovs the person's mind. But there is another way the person's mind may be "destroyed". That person may think of nothing but sex all the time. This way he ruins himself! Romans 1:21-22 helps us understand this: "People's thinking became foolish Their were filled with darkness (sin). People said they were and they became fools." 24 adds, "So God left them and let them go their wav."

And yes, you are right, God will forgive the person who repents of his sexual sin. But remember the word "repent" means a change of mind. The sexual sinner must decide in his mind that sexual sin is wrong, and he must actually turn away from it. If he is sincere in wanting to quit his sin, he can ask Christ for help to do so. See Philippians 4:13.

I thought Jesus says a person must eat for good health. But what did He mean in Matthew 6:25 when He says not to worry about food?

First, in verse 24 Jesus is talking about the fact that a person cannot serve two masters ("bosses") at the same time. Which comes first, God or mon-

ev? That is what Iesus talked about in verse 24. Then in verse 25 lesus tells the people not to worry about food or the clothes they need for their bodies. Jesus pointed out that the birds in the air and the flowers in the field don't have jobs. God feeds the birds and clothes the flowers! That is why Jesus goes on to say, "Don't worry and say, 'What will we eat?' or 'What will we drink?' or 'What will we wear?' (verse 31)?" Why? "Because your Father in heaven knows that you need these things (verse 32)." So have faith in God and He will give you the food and clothes you need. "The thing you should want most is God's kingdom and being right with Him. Then all these other things you need will be given to you (verse 33)." Yes, Jesus would want us to eat for good health, but He does not want us to worry about where we will get food if we have no money. God will take care of us!

#### Can a person who is a Christian visit his deaf friends at a Deaf Club?

It will depend! Some Deaf Clubs are clean and nice in some areas. But in other areas they allow alcoholic beverages, gambling and other sins. your influence would be ruined by going to a Deaf Club, then it is wise not to go. Paul warns the church in Ephesus, "Don't continue living like those people who don't believe (Ephesians 4:17)." And in verse 22 Paul says, "You were taught to leave your old self-- to stop living the evil way you lived before. Again, Paul said to the church in Corinth: "Don't be fooled: 'Bad friends will ruin good habits' (1 Corinthians 15:33)." But

if your influence is strong enough that it might help your deaf friends see Christ in your life, then it is good to go. You will have to use your judgment in this matter.

#### Is it true that sinners can't do anything against Christians because Christians have strong faith? See Mark 9:38.

Not true! Remember Stephen was full of mighty faith, yet the Jewish leaders still killed him (Acts 6:5; 7:57-60). notice that Jesus told Peter that he would die for his faith (John 21:18-19). And Paul himself was killed because of his faith (2 Timothy 4:6). But of course sinners cannot take away our faith if we stay with Christ. But what does Mark 9:38 mean? Here's an explanation that will help you understand: the apostle John noticed that there was a man who was not one of the twelve apostles. But that one man was forcing out demons from a person. John and some of the other apostles told the man to stop because he was of the twelve apostles. But Jesus answered, "Don't stop him (verse 39)." It seems that Jesus approved of the man although the man was not one of the twelve apostles. Understand Mark 9:38 now?

## Can we pray for sinners because they don't know God or believe in God?

Of course we can, and should, pray for the lost, but we should not forget to pray for laborers (evangelists, soulwinners, teachers, etc.) (Matthew 9:37-38). And of course if we are able, we should go to these people ourselves and tell them of Jesus!

It reached its present form a few years before the 20th century began.

Your latest issue of LIGHT is great. Yes, keep up with cartoon strips— they are not comic stuff, but they teach the scriptural truths

in the simplest form. I know you are very conscientious and you are very, very careful to teach the gospel truth. May God bless you with many more years of this great work. You are the only one in the brotherhood who has this rare, special gift.




