three months in 1991!



PAUL THEN WROTE THE CHURCH AGAIN AND TOLD THEM TO FORGIVE THIS MAN.



## Faith- How It Comes and Grows

Most of us learned long ago that "so faith comes from hearing the Good News" (Romans 10:17). Peter reminded the apostles and elders at Jerusalem that God had chosen him, that "God chose me then from among you to preach the Good News to the non-Jewish people... and they believed" (Acts 15:17).

Of the signs which Jesus did, John said, 'These things are written so that you can believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God" (John 20:31). When the Philippian jailer was told to "believe on the Lord Jesus Christ", it was necessary for Paul and Silas to speak unto him the word of the Lord that he and his family might believe (Acts 16:30-32).

But for those of us who have already believed and obeyed the gospel, our need is for our faith to grow. I suggest that faith grows in the same way it comes-- through hearing the word of God. As we learn more about God and Jesus Christ through the word, our faith grows. As we learn more of the love, power and faithfulness of God, our faith in Him is increased.


We sometimes study the lives of great men like Abraham, observing their faith. But as we study the *faith* of Abraham, we also see the *faithfulness* of God. If God had not been faithful, Abraham's faith would have had little significance.


