




Basics of Marriage & Divorce

MARRIAGE




"So a man will leave his father and his mother and be joined to his wife. And the two people will become one."

Genesis 2:24


"God joined those two people together. So no person should separate them."

What about those preachers who do not teach baptism, or who do not teach baptism is for the remission of sins?

It is sad that these preachers do not believe in baptism for the remission of sins. Jesus plainly taught baptism as part of our response to the Good 16:16; (Mark Matthew News 28:19). Baptism does not have any "magic" power to cleanse us of our sins. The apostle Peter wrote, "Baptism is not the washing of dirt from the Baptism is asking God for a pure heart. It [baptism] saves you because Jesus Christ was raised from death" (1 Peter What Peter said here is that baptism is the response of an honest person who now believes in Christ and who wants Him to wash his sins away. This is why sometimes the person who is baptized is said to "wash away his sins" (Acts 22:16)-it is not the person himself who washes away his sins, but Christ. Paul teaches us that we become part of Christ when we are baptized; we also share His death, burial and resurrection (Romans 6:3-4). Paul says the

same thing in Colossians 2:12, but puts the emphasis on faith:
"And in that baptism you were raised up with Christ because of your faith in God's power. God's power was shown when He raised Christ from death."

Then there are Peter's words in Acts 2:38. He commanded those who believed in Christ to be baptized, so that their sins could be taken away. The King James Version says, "For the remission of sins." The EVD says, "Then God will forgive your sins." The Greek word translated "remission" in the King James Version of Acts 2:38 means "removal"-- a taking away. When we are baptized into Christ, our sins are taken away, or removed.

So those preachers who deny baptism, or those who teach baptism does not take away sins, are hurting the truth and hurting those people who hear them.

What will happen to people who believe in Jesus Christ, but their churches are different?

Let's look at a few facts before we answer this question:

- l. Jesus Christ is the only way to the Father (John 14:6), He is the truth and life. Only under His name can we be be saved (Acts 4:12).
- Jesus Christ has only one church.
 This church is also called His body or God's family (Ephesians 4:4; Romans 12:5; I Corinthlans 12:12-13).
- Jesus not only told the apostles to go out into all the world and teach people to be disciples disciples (followers) of Jesus, but also to obey all the things Jesus taught (Matthew 28:19-20).

The above facts are simple. Jesus Christ, not the church, is the only way to the Father. The church is all the believers saved by Jesus. We are taught to obey all the things Jesus commanded.

Many people teach things different from the Bible. These people make many changes in what the Bible teaches. This is against what God says (Revelation 22:18,19). It is sad that there are different religious groups that cause confusion

among people and divide them, Jesus warned, "Every plant that My Father in heaven has not planted Himself will be pulled out by the roots" (Matthew 15:13). The context shows Jesus was talking about the Pharisees' traditions which they tried to teach as part of God's Word (verses 1-14).

But we still must remember Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life, and no person comes to the Father except through Jesus Christ. The church does not make you "right with God". The church does not save you. Only Jesus does that. is why the Bible warns both individuals and congregations to examine themselves to see if they live in the faith (2 Corinthians 13:5 and Revelation 2-3).

What about individuals in those different Will groups? God take them to eternal glory no matter if they make mistakes? Our answer is that it is not our business to judge anyone, It is God's business. But the business God did give us is to try to teach people to believe in Jesus, and to try to give the correct teachings that Jesus gave us in the Bible. Read again Acts 4:19 and Matthew 28:19-20.

What about those people who "feel" they are saved? Is not Jesus the only One who saves us?

"Feeling" you are saved is dangerous. A person might "feel" he is in perfect health, yet the next moment fall over dead from a sudden heart attack. The same is true with spiritual things. We should not trust

our "feelings". Our feelings can fool us. We must know for sure if we are saved (I John 5:13). You are right, Jesus is the only One who saves us (Acts 4:12).

Cruelty

We have seen that adultery is not the only reason that many divorces happen. Another, very common reason, is **cruelty.** An example is **wifebeating.** Husband-beating also happens, but is rare.

No person should suffer cruelty at the hands of his/her spouse. The same verse that tells us God hates divorce also says He hates the cruel things men do (to their wives) (Malachi 2:16).

If you are a person who beats your wife, or who does cruel things to her, please read the above verse from Malachi. God is against men who beat their wives. The same is true for those few women who beat their husbands or who do cruel things to them.

Also, God warns that a person should take care of all the people in his own family (1 Timothy 5:8). If this person will not take care of his family, then God says two terrible things about this person: (1) This person is refusing to accept the true faith; and (2) This person is worse than an unbeliever. We remember what will happen to people who refuse to accept the faith (2 Thessalonians 1:8-9).

God's grace teaches us to live on earth in a way that is wise and right (Titus 2:12). This means we should do right by our spouses and families, and not only be kind to them, but love them!

The key to a happier marriage, and family, is to begin with yourself.
