












### Promises of the

An easier title for the above is "For wherever you go." This is the slogan that the Leader Dog for the Blind uses to express that the guide dog can lead the blind to a more distant place. I am legally blind and I have one of their dogs to help me be safer when I travel around town to visit people.

I must take care of my dog well and he will take care of me well also. I must continue to train him until he retires. If I stop using him or training him, he would forget everything that he was supposed to do for me.

This is the same for us as Christians and our Bibles. If we don't use our Bibles and take care of God's word well, the Devil will set traps for us to fall into. The more we use God's word every day, the safer we are from falling into Satan's traps. Read 1 John 2:14:

"I write to you, children, because you know the Father. I write to you, fathers, because you know the One who existed (lived) from the Beginning. I write to you, young men, because you are strong;

### the Word of God lives in you, and you have defeated the Evil One." --1 John 2:14, EVD

This scripture tells us the reason why we need the Bible is that it will make us "strong "Christians and it will keep us from falling into Satan's traps ("defeated the Evil One"). There are many reasons for studying the Word of God. Let's look at nine reasons why we need the Words of God (Bible) to help guide our life:

1. It will make us strong. 1 John 2:14

5. It will give us joy. John 15:11

6. It will produce peace. John 16:33 and Colossians 3:15

7. It guides us in making the decisions of life. Psalm 119:105

8. It helps you to share your faith. 1 Peter 3:15

9. It guarantees your success. Joshua 1:8

My leader dog helps me be safer when I travel around town or other places but the Bible keeps me safe from Satan. My dog also gives me more independence, not being tied down to one place. The Bible gives me even more wonderful things in life.

Let's look at the way for happiness found in the first Psalm:

# The Truth About SEX

The Bible tells us God created humans "male and female" (Genesis 1:27). If this is true (and here at **Light for the Deaf** we believe it is), then God created sex! Should we blame God for creating something nasty or dirty? No! Why? Because the Bible also says, "God looked at everything He had made, and God saw that everything was very good" (Genesis 1:31, EVD). Everything? Yes! That includes sex!

In addition, the Bible tells us that God gave Adam and Eve a *blessing*. "God said to them, 'Have many children and spread across the earth" (Genesis 1:28, **EVD**). In the original language (and shown in many translations, including the **King James Version**), it is said God told Adam and Eve to "be fruitful". Of course God did not talk about apples, oranges, grapes, etc. No, what God told Adam and Eve was for them to have babies. The **EVD** gives us a clear understanding of what God was trying to tell Adam and Eve.

And if Adam and Eve were to have many children for them to spread across the earth, they would have to have sex. But God blessed them. That shows God is pleased with sex! After all, it was He who created sex!

We later read in Genesis 4:1, "Adam and his wife Eve had sexual relations. And Eve gave birth to a baby. The baby was named Cain". Eve was very happy when Cain was born, for she proudly said, "With the Lord's help, I have made a man!"

Is sex dirty? No! God created sex. But He has made laws about sex that we must obey. If we do not obey these laws about sex, then it does

become dirty. Sex is *very good--* if we obey the laws God has set up on this very important part of our lives.

In Hebrews 13:4 God says, "Marriage should be honored by all people. And every marriage should be kept pure between only two people. God will judge guilty those people who do sexual sins and adultery".

This very important verse tells us marriage should be honored. The original Greek the **EVD** translated "honored" means precious and dear. This is excellent advice for us today! Marriage should be thought of as somethimg **precious**, **dear and worthy to be honored**. It is sad that so many people today think marriage is nothing. They think it is not important. They think it is all right to violate your vows and have sex with someone you are not married to.

When we turn to the **King James Version**, we read that the "bed is undefiled". The word "undefiled" means **not dirty**. This verse talks about sex on the bed. When a man and woman are married to each other, and they have sexual intercourse, their sex is clean and approved by God. In this way, the bed is "undefiled" (**not dirty**). That is why the **EVD** translates this verse to read, "Every marriage should be kept pure between only two people."

But this verse goes on to say God will judge *guilty* those people who do **sexual sins** and **adultery**. The **King James Version** uses the words "whoremonger" and "adulterer". The word "whoremonger" is an old English word we do not use today. It means a fornicator, a person who does the sin of fornication. And what is "fornication"? It means **sexual sin**. So a "whoremonger" is a **sexual sinner**. You understand now why the **EVD** translated, "those people who do sexual sins". Fornication covers all kinds of **sexual sin**. Below are examples of fornication:

- Sexual intercourse between unmarried couples.
- 2. Adultery (a married person having sexual intercourse with someone not his or her spouse).
- 3. Rape (forcing a person to have sex with you).
- 4. Incest (sexual intercourse with a member of your own family).
- 5. Homosexuality (both male "gays" and female lesbians).

There are many other sexual sins, but the above are the most practiced today. And by looking at the above list, you can get an idea of what is meant by "sexual sins".

The apostle Paul says, "Flee fornication" (1 Corinthians 6:18, KJV). The EVD makes this clear for deaf readers: "So run away from sexual sin." In the Old Testament, when Potiphar's wife tried to tempt Joseph into the sin of adultery, he ran away (Genesis 39:7-12). Joseph knew if he stayed, the temptation would be too strong for him to stand against. He knew he would fall into sin then.

The person who is saved by Christ should turn away from sin. He should not defile (make dirty) his body by doing sexual sins. A study of Ephesians 5:3 (both KJV and EVD) shows fornication (sexual sin), uncleanness (dirty life), and covetousness (evil desire) should not even once be named among God's holy people, Christians.


Yes, you are to run away from sexual sin! Sin is *not* dirty. But it will become dirty if you use it in the wrong way!

#### Is it true denominations are not found in the Bible?

You are right, there are no denominations in the Bible. The word denomination means something that is named and a division of something. For example, American money is divided into \$1 denominations, \$5 denominations, \$10 denominations, \$20 denominations, etc. When we talk about religious matters, a denomination means a division of the Lord's church.

The apostle Paul in 1 Corinthians 1:10 plainly tells the church in Corinth "that there be no divisions among you." That church in Corinth was dividing up into smaller groups each of which followed different preachers: Peter, Apollos, and Paul himself (v. 11-12). Paul said this meant the church in Corinth was not spiritual ("carnal", KJV) (1 Corinthians 3:3).

It is a shame that we divide ourselves into smaller groups, often criticizing each other.


Paul said the only thing he decided to know among the people in Corinth was Christ, and Him crucified (nailed on a cross) (1 Corinthians 2:2). This is the Good News, or gospel (1 Corinthians 15:1-4), and it shows God's power to save (1 Corinthians 2:4-5). Those who work for Christ are just servants who help people to believe in Christ (1 Corinthians 3:5).

It is best to believe in Jesus. Christ and His power to save as well as to obey Him. We should be just plain followers of Him. This is what the New Testament teaches. Then we will be members of His one and only New Testament church (Matthew 16:18, Acts 2:47), and not of some man-made denomination.


